FREE TAX PREPARATION OPTIONS

NSAP is unable to offer the on-site AARP Tax Aide services this year as we have in the past. Below are some other alternatives for free tax services. Go to https://bit.ly/2LuoPWz for more options or call 218-226-3635.

- Two Harbors: Contact Phyllis Mealy to schedule an appointment with the AARP Tax Aide program in Two Harbors. Call 218-834-4379.
- Tofte: Drop off your tax documents at the Tofte Town Hall between 9 am & 12 pm Tuesdays through 4/13/21. Cook County VITA/TCE tax assistance volunteers will arrange for your return to be prepared.
- Silver Bay: For individuals age 60+ who have previously used our tax assistance, but are unable to travel to these alternative sites. NSAP will deliver your documents to the Cook County VITA/TCE program. Call Nancy Christenson at 218-226-3635 for instructions and to make arrangements for this service. Bring a copy of your ID, social security card, prior year state and federal returns, and all current tax documents to ensure your file is complete.

NEED A RIDE TO YOUR VACCINE APPOINTMENT?

As vaccine becomes available, it will be distributed through pop-up clinics in Two Harbors by appointment on a first come first served basis for Lake County residents age 65+. NSAP staff is working on identifying ways we can assist with this process.

We have a pool of volunteer drivers who are able to provide transportation as needed. Please call us at least 48 hours before you will need your ride at 218-226-3635. Available for those 60+.
